HANDMADE

All planters are handcrafted from Glass Fiber Reinforced Cement and are one-of-a-kind productions. Works are each unique and never exactly the same; variations in color and final results are part of the handmade quality.

CARE

In areas with prolonged freezing temperatures, cover during winter months. Spot clean with a wet cloth and soap, pressure wash not recommended. Our work is durable yet fragile, handle with care.

PLANTING

Planters are both indoor and outdoor safe and are equipped with a drainage hole. An interior liner is recommended to reduce water exposure. If planting directly into the planter be sure to use adequate plantings techniques to ensure proper drainage of water. We recommend to consult a nursery for the best planting application for your space and plant. Proper plantings techniques to preserve the integrity of the planter are solely the responsibility of the client.
